Environment	Participants	Range where activity is to take place checked by instructor prior to session starting.  Range is well ventilated.	
Injury	Participants & instructor	Supervision of activity by instructor and safety talk at start Safety glasses worn when shooting. Spectators to stay behind Perspex screen. All guns not loaded and laid down before instructor walks in front of line to targets.	
Poisoning	Participants	Instructor to advise all participants to wash hands after session and no food or drink to be brought into the range.	
Distraction/ noise	Participants	Range is sound insulated, mobile phones to be switched off or put on silent whilst in the range. Spectators and bystanders to be kept away from shooters.	
Child protection	Participants	Instructor DBS checked and Scouts yellow card followed at all times.
