

Bouldering Wall Rules

- Agreement to having read and understood these rules must be signed for by the camp leader before commencement of the activity, whom will be liable for the duration of the activity booking.
- 2. The activity can only be run and supervised by a competent adult. They must have read and understood the risk assessment and rules and ensure they are adhered to at all times.
- 3. The camp leader must ensure that adequate first aid cover is available at the activity.
- 4. The activity leader must check all wall bolts and hand holds before the activity commences.
- 5. A safety talk should be given to all activity users before the activity starts.
- 6. Climbers feet must never go higher than the white line.
- 7. Climbers must not hold on to the top frame.
- 8. No horse play is allowed.
- 9. The ground area inside the wall / fall area must be kept clear at all times.
- 10.A buddy system can be used to assist climbers by standing on the ground behind the climber to offer support.
- 11.Do not allow too many people inside the wall at once.
- 12. The door must be locked while the activity in not in use.
